

Bard College Berlin invites applications for a **2-year Postdoctoral Fellowship in Politics**

Candidates should be prepared to co-teach a course introducing the study of politics, and courses in at least one of the following areas: comparative politics, international relations or policy analysis. Applicants should have a PhD in political science or a related field by the start date of the position (31 August 2026).

The appointed candidate will teach 2 courses per semester and conduct research in their field as a member of the politics faculty.

1. A cover letter outlining motivation for applying to this position.
2. A curriculum vitae (CV) including a list of publications.
3. A short research statement (1-2 pages) summarizing past research and outlining future research plans.
4. A teaching statement (max. 1 page) describing teaching experience and approach.
5. One writing sample (e.g., a published article or book chapter).
6. Names and contact information for two academic references.

Shortlisted candidates will be invited for an online interview in June.
