Statement of Purpose

The statement of purpose should be around 750 words and must be reviewed by your academic advisor.

- 1) Please describe your reasons for choosing your host institution(s) for study abroad. Make sure to address the type of program offered and its relationship to your intended concentration at BCB.
- 2) Check the course list at your prospective host institution(s); which courses appeal to you and why?
- 3) Describe briefly the relationship between your study abroad preferences and your future plans. How do you plan to fulfill your remaining concentration modules and the math/science requirement? Do your study abroad preferences relate to your thesis project at BCB or your plans after graduation? If yes, how?
